She has been racing against top mares north and south of the border for the last several years, competing at no less than 10 tracks since graduating from the Indiana Fair S. program. A 26-time career winner, she has been racing at the top of her game recently, as evidenced by her 1:50.3-.27.3 recent performance at Woodbine, against horses like Kendall Seelster (and finishing in front of Treacherous Reign). Interestingly, it was the fastest she had ever paced, and she did it in her 118th lifetime start! The start before that, she was a 1:52 winner at Woodbine, and she equaled her previous lifetime best (1:51.1f) on July 16, winning in 1:51.1 at Woodbine with a last 1/4 in :27.3. By the 1:46 sire ALWAYS A VIRGIN p,3,1:48.4 (\$1.1M), she has shown the ability to win over all size tracks and has been ultra-consistent, hitting the board in just under 50% of her lifetime starts and is still a fierce competitor.
